REDUCING THE DEMAND FOR DRUGS

COMMUNITY TREATMENT PROJECT IN DAGRIGA TO SERVE MIGRANT POPULATION

Support to the National Drug Abuse Control Council to promote a pilot project for community treatment in Dangriga, in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, Community Police and humanitarian NGOs (Red Cross, HelpAge). The aim is to improve the care of alcohol, drug and homelessness problems among migrant populations (especially

Garifuna) through inter-agency cooperation to avoid duplication of work. We aim to set up a monthly stand offering legal assistance to the migrant population.
