



S COUNTRY FACT SHEET:

OPOLAD supports Brazil in the implementation of the National Drug Policy. Technical support is channelled through three national actions, three regional initiatives, and through the country's participation in three of the programme's working groups.

The programme's support is aimed at strengthening the National Drug Observatory (drug information and research systems) and the demand reduction component (comprehensive intervention projects in communities with high social vulnerability).

STRENGTHENING DRUG OBSERVATORIES

STRENGTHENING THE NATIONAL DRUG INFORMATION AND RESEARCH SYSTEM

A mapping of human, financial and institutional resources has been developed, which has enabled the configuration of a national research network, led by the NDO. This process is accompanied by the creation of a Scientific Committee on Drugs, which will systematically advise the observatory.



REDUCING THE DEMAND FOR DRUGS

"ALIANZA" PROJECT FOR THE LIFE OF THE YOUTH OF FORTALEZA

The Municipality of Fortaleza is supported in promoting a violence and addiction prevention project aimed at vulnerable young people in two communities (Jangurussu and São Francisco).

ACCREDITED PROJECT

The Drug Policy Secretariat of the State of Ceará is supported in the development of a project aimed at the prevention, care and social reintegration of people in vulnerable situations and with problematic consumption of alcohol and other drugs in two communities (Oitão Preto and Papicu).
