






OPOLAD accompanies El Salvador in the implementation of its *National Anti-Drug Strategy* 2016-2021. Technical support is channelled through two national actions, three regional initiatives, and through the country's participation in six of the

programme's working groups. The programme's support is directed toward the components of reduction in demand (care for children and adolescents) and supply (control of chemical precursors).

REDUCING THE DEMAND FOR DRUGS

IMPROVING CARE FOR INSTITUTIONALISED CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS

Technical support to improve the technical-scientific-clinical capacity of the teams to provide quality, comprehensive and evidence-based care to institutionalised children and adolescents and their families. The main results of this support are: a diagnosis of needs as regards training and quality of care for healthcare teams and institutions, and a training guide and a care protocol with quality standards and based on evidence.



CONTROL OF CHEMICAL PRECURSORS:

PREPARATION OF A MANUAL FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND FINAL DISPOSAL OF CHEMICAL PRECURSORS

Support for preparing a diagnosis of precursor management in the country (including the legislative and regulatory framework, institutional mapping and aggregated statistical information), with a view to preparing a comprehensive manual for the management and final disposal of chemical precursors.

Within the framework of this support,

a study visit to Costa Rica has been promoted and online training activities on the manual have been carried out for the country's technical staff.
