STRENGTHENING DRUG OBSERVATORIES

STRENGTHENING THE NATIONAL DRUG INFORMATION AND RESEARCH SYSTEM

A mapping of human, financial and institutional resources has been developed, which has enabled the creation of a national research network, led by the NDO. This

process is accompanied by the creation of a Scientific Committee on Drugs, which will systematically advise the observatory. These advances are complemented by the

development of the national agenda on drugs, scheduled for the first half of 2025, which will set out the country's research priorities.
