COPOLAD III accompanies Saint Vincent and the Grenadines in implementing its National Anti-Drug Plan, through technical support for two regional initiatives, and through the country's participation in

four of the Programme's working groups. The country has participated very actively in the Working Group on Comprehensive and Sustainable Alternative Development, particularly as regards traditional cannabis.
